Data

- Official data only
- National sources of data preferred
- UN COMTRADE database as a main source of trade data dissagregated by flow, partner country and commodity
- Azerbaijan, PRC, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic and Mongolia regularly report to COMTRADE
- Afghanistan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan do not report
- There are no data on XUAR trade in this database

Data (2)


- Other national and sub-national sources (websites and publications of government agencies) used to fill in gaps in COMTRADE
- When national data are not sufficient, IMF estimates and mirror statistics used
- In general, created database of intra-regional trade provides detailed information on geographical patterns and commodity structure of trade between CAREC members


Dynamics of Intra-Regional Trade

 Total turnover of the intra-regional trade is defined as a sum of exports of every CAREC member to all other CAREC members




Dynamics of Intra-Regional Trade (2)

Country shares in the intra-regional trade turnover, 2007




Dynamics of Intra-Regional Trade (3)

 Share of intra-regional trade turnover in total trade turnover of the countries of the region, 2000-2007





Turnover of trade with other CAREC countries





Patterns of Bilateral Trade (2)

Conclusions

- Exports and imports in all countries of the region were growing very fast in 2000-2008
- Countries-exporters of mineral fuels and XUAR registered large positive trade balances by 2008
- Exports of all CAREC members but XUAR are concentrated on very few primary commodities (mineral fuels, ferrous and non-ferrous metals, cotton, wheat)
- China has grown to a role of one of the most important partners for all other countries of the region

Conclusions (2)

- Intra-regional trade was growing very fast in 2000-2008 and faster than total trade of these countries
- The main driver of this growth was trade of XUAR with other CAREC countries
- Trade between "CAREC minus XUAR" countries also increased much in absolute terms, but not as a share of total trade turnover of these countries
- XUAR is very much dependent on trade with other CAREC countries; Central Asian countries and Afghanistan significantly depend on trade with these partners too

Conclusions (3)

- Intra-regional trade is concentrated on a very limited set of commodities: imports of light industry goods from China, supplies of energy products and metals and ores, some agricultural exports
- Data on intra-regional trade should be taken with caution; very large discrepancies in mirror statistics suggest that some large trade flows, especially reexports, come unaccounted
- Many of these trends had taken place in times of good global economic growth and high international prices for commodities exported by CAREC countries; current global economic crisis may change these trends in less favorable direction
