Statement by His Excellency Mr. Jun Yamada Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to the Republic of Kazakhstan 23rd Ministerial Conference Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Program 7-8 November 2024, Astana

Distinguished guests, Ladies and Gentlemen!

On behalf of the Government of Japan, I would like to congratulate the Asian Development Bank, which serves as the CAREC Secretariat, and the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan on holding today's important meeting. Japan appreciates the constructive role of CAREC which actively promotes mutual relationship and cooperation among Central Asia / Caucasus and neighboring countries

More than anything, Japan welcomes the initiatives by CAREC member states to revitalize regional cooperation in the era of rapid and drastic changes. This will certainly contribute to the autonomous and sustainable development of CAREC members. Japan is determined to promote further development of this region, on the basis of long-standing friendly and cooperative relationship with the CAREC member states.

Being surrounded by Asia, Europe and the Middle East, many CAREC members including those in the Central Asia and Caucasus are such vital existences for so many other countries. Japan will continue such cooperation

with CAREC countries including Central Asia still further, so that we could make a meaningful contribution to the region's autonomous and sustainable economic development, poverty reduction, and cleaner environment. In doing so, we will always focus on the perspectives of human development, growth with quality and regional connectivity.

Japan highly values CAREC's important role in providing a constructive platform for such regional cooperation. We will strive to safeguard and further enhance a rule-based international order by upgrading already very close and friendly relations with CAREC member states, which aspire for free, open and sustainable development. It is a great honor for Japan to continue to pursue such development by cooperating with CAREC member states, ADB, international financial institutions and other donor countries ever more closely.
