USAID CTJ's Technical Assistance

- Review and analysis of SPS **legislation** to ensure consistency with international agreements (WTO SPS Agreement, IPPC)
- Capacity building **trainings** for SPS staff:
 - PRA Training in Dushanbe, February 26-28, 2019
 - Trainings on ISPM: 4, 6, 7, 8, 12, 17, 19, 23
- **Information** on the phytosanitary import requirements of key export markets (guide for exporters)
- Support in preparing laboratories for international **accreditation** (ISO 17025)
- Accession/membership of C5+1 member countries to the **IPPC and the EPPO**



Outcomes of the USAID CTJ:

Technical support to the SPQI of Uzbekistan, May 2018

- Review of the draft Law “On Plant Quarantine”
- Workshops for SPQI staff and private sector



PRA training in Dushanbe, February 26-28, 2019

- 17 participants from 4 Central Asian countries
- The methodology to conduct PRA using CAPRA
- Implementing pilot PRAs in Central Asian countries



Outcomes of the USAID CTJ:

Guidelines 'Phytosanitary Requirements in Export Markets'

- Countries: EU, EAEU, ASEAN, GCC, Japan, Korea
- Outline/content of the Guideline
 - National plant protection organization (NPPO)
 - Phytosanitary legislation and regulations
 - Phytosanitary certificate
 - Requirements for inspections (audit)
 - Wood packaging material
 - Treatment of cargos, including fumigation
 - Import of goods (special regimes, import quarantine permits - IQP)
 - Requirements for certain types of goods
 - Packaging material
