The 25th Meeting of the CAREC Customs Cooperation Committee (CCC) provides a platform for member countries to assess progress in implementing the CCC Work Plan 2025–2026 and to align ongoing and future initiatives with the broader goals of the CAREC Integrated Trade Agenda (CITA) 2030.

Objectives

- (1) To review the implementation progress of subregional and national projects under the CCC Work Plan 2025–2026;
- (2) To discuss ongoing trade facilitation initiatives under the CCC priority areas and the CAREC Integrated Trade Agenda 2030, including its Rolling Strategic Action Plan, and to seek feedback from CCC members;
- (3) To develop plans and activities to support key customs cooperation areas, such as integrated risk management, regional transit facilitation, green customs, digitalization, and paperless trade;
- (4) To agree on the CCC Work Plan 2026–2027 and identify future activities for inclusion in a new ADB technical assistance project aimed at enhancing the capacity of customs administrations in the region; and
- (5) To adopt the 25th CCC Summary of Proceedings and CCC Report to the CAREC Senior Officials' Meeting.
