Major achievements in the HE systems in Pakistan over the last 10 years














Main achievements in the TVET and HE systems in Pakistan over the last 10 years

Punjab Skills Development Fund (PSDF)








- ➤ PSDF is the largest skills development fund in Pakistan

- 250+ Demand-Driven Trades
- 500 + Training Services
- PRS 21bn annual Income
- Total fund allocation USD 32.2 million
