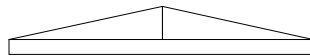

## Regional Dispatch and Regulatory Development

### Action Plan Objective

To maximize the benefits of unified operation of the Central Asia power system (CAPS).

### Why

- CAPS started as an integrated operation post Soviet Era.
- The Global trend shows benefits and preference for integration of grids ( within country, region and even beyond) to maximize benefits lower costs).
- Opportunities for lowering Carbon foot prints, inter regional trade and lowering overall investments in the region.

### How

#### Capacity Building & Knowledge Sharing

Develop an Institutional framework for regional power trade based on economic principles. This platform could be within the CDC?

#### Investments supporting National and Regional goals.

Phased investments to strengthen SCADA, Metering/ data acquisition, Communication and Transmission systems in accordance with National needs and circumstances.

#### Policy measures

Strengthening CDC, National Load Dispatch Centers and facilitating preparation of Regulations

## Regional Dispatch and Regulatory Coordination Technical Sub-Committee Draft Terms of Reference
