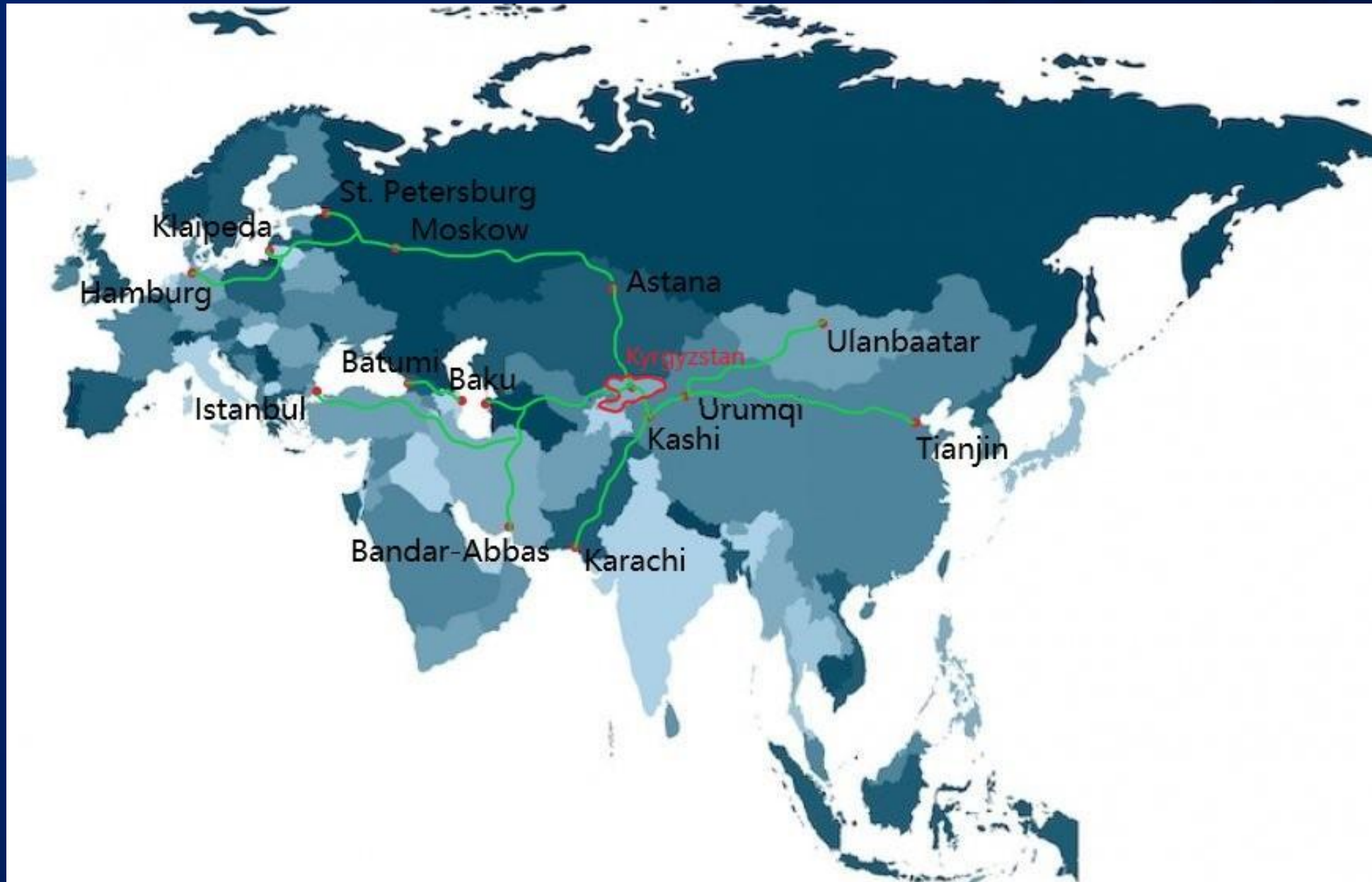

E-CMR: DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION OF INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT

The Kyrgyz Republic is actively introducing electronic international consignment notes (e-CMR) to facilitate, digitalize and enhance the efficiency of international road transport.



LEGAL FRAMEWORK

- Accession to international conventions and protocols.
- The legal framework for the use of e-CMR is in place.
- Harmonization of legislation on international transport operations.

- The Working Group is established.
- DTS and EDT operators are identified.

E-CMR is an important step towards establishing a unified digital transport space and enhancing competitiveness of the Kyrgyz Republic in the region and at the international level.



- During the meeting of the SCO Ministers of Transport held on April 23, 2026, the Ministry of Transport and Communications of the Kyrgyz Republic initiated and signed the Memorandum of Understanding on the introduction of electronic permit forms (E-Permit) among the SCO countries, which will allow carriers of the SCO countries to receive permit forms in the electronic format.
- Besides, the Kyrgyz Republic initiated and signed the Memorandum of Understanding among the Ministries of Transport of the Organization of Turkic States on the introduction of the "e-CMR" – an electronic version of the international consignment note – at the meeting of the Ministers of Transport of the member countries of the Turkic States. The purpose of the Memorandum is to achieve cooperation in the field of digitalization of international road freight transport through the introduction of e-CMR based on existing experience, the use of information technology, standardization of international road transport management among the Parties and increasing the level of simplification of international road transport.
