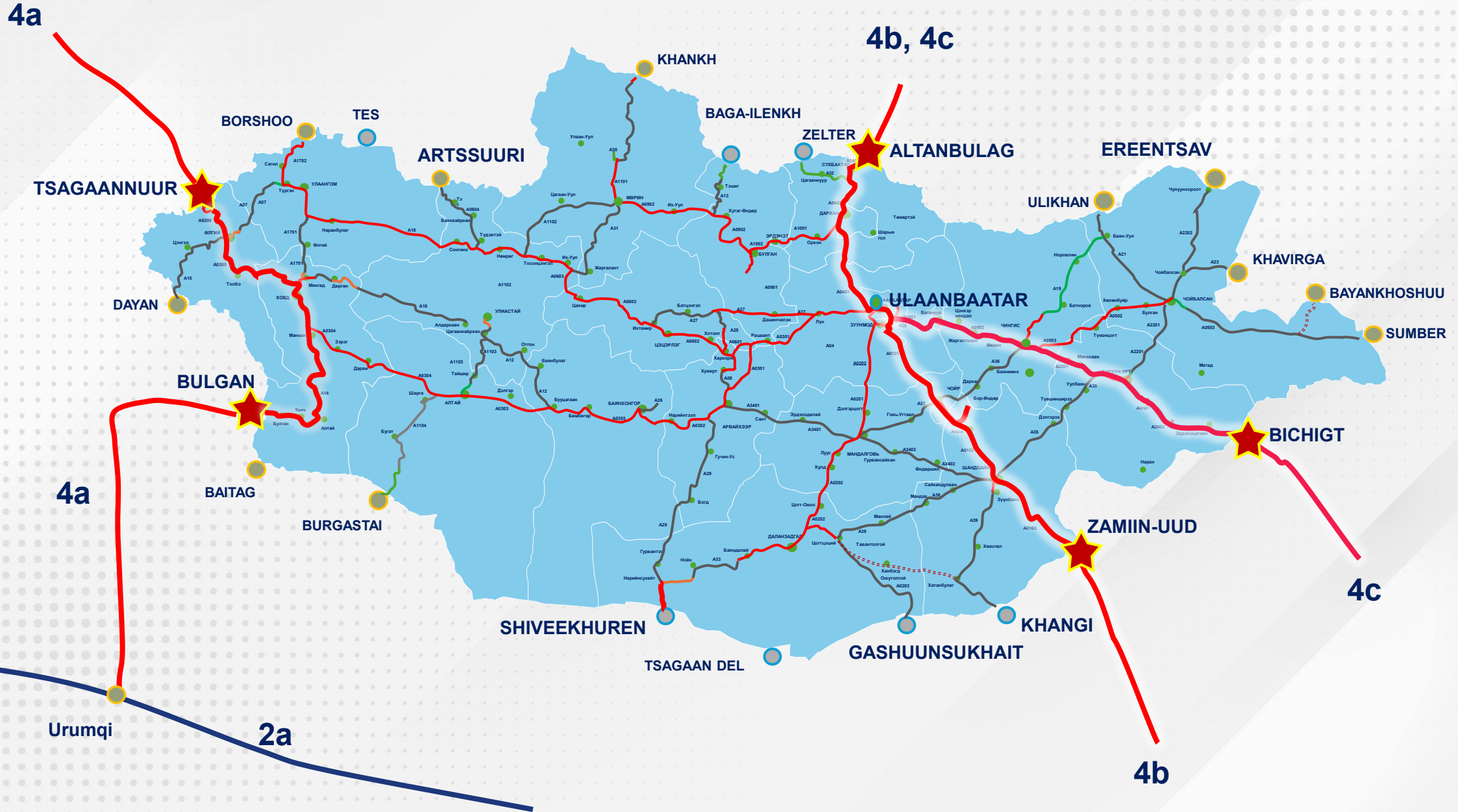

Under CAREC Corridor **4a**, **745.8** km of paved road along the Yarant-Ulaanbaishint route was completed between 2005-2022.

- **406.5** km financed by the Asian Development Bank,
- **145.3** km financed through a concessional loan from the Government of Mongolia and the Export-Import Bank of China,
- **194** km financed by the Government of Mongolia.

The CAREC Corridor **4b** section in Mongolia extends approximately **1,041** km and was developed between 2000-2014 (2025) with support from:

- Asian Development Bank (ADB): Ulaanbaatar–Darkhan–Altanbulag (**312** km), Nalaikh–Choir (**200** km);
- European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD): Ulaanbaatar–Darkhan 4-lane expansion (**202.1** km);
- Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC): Choir–Sainshand (**176.4** km);
- Government of Mongolia: various sections totaling **150.5** km.

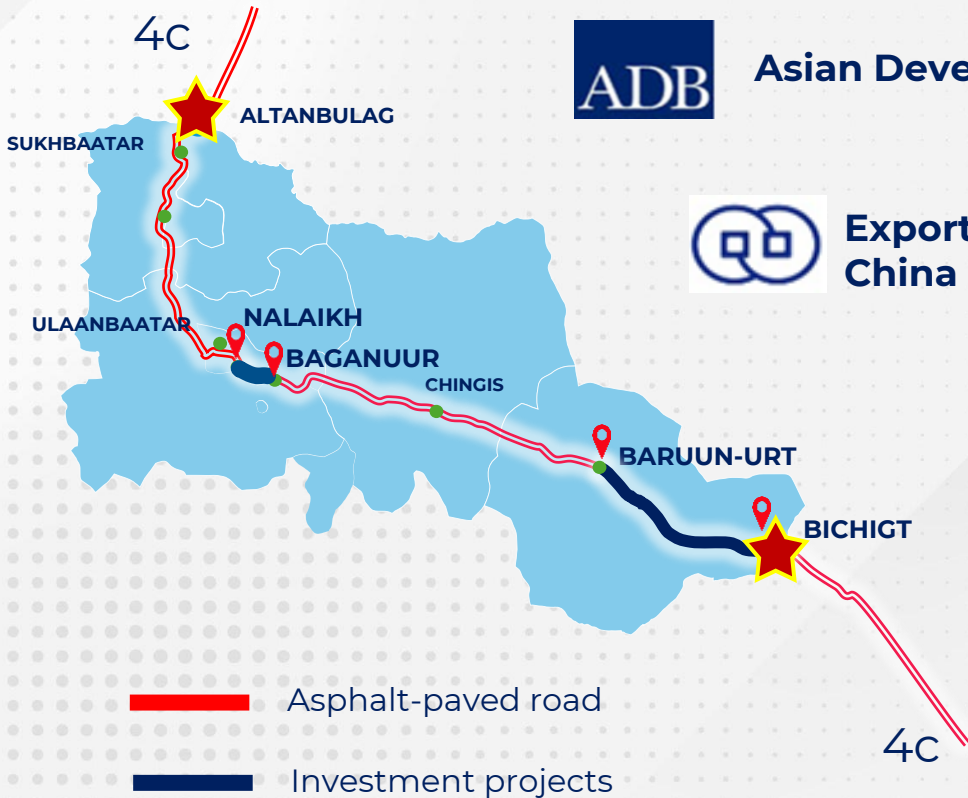

The total length of the CAREC Corridor **4c** section passing through Mongolia is approximately **1,114** km, comprising the following road projects:

- Asian Development Bank (ADB): Ulaanbaatar–Darkhan–Altanbulag(**312** km);
- Ulaanbaatar–Nalaikh (**20.9** km) - the Export-Import Bank of China and the Government of Mongolia;
- Government of Mongolia
 - Ulaanbaatar–Undurkhaan (**333** km);
 - Undurkhaan–Baruun-Urt (**178** km);
 - Baruun-Urt–Bichigt Road(**270** km)

CAREC CORRIDORS IN MONGOLIA: ONGOING AND PLANNED MEASURES

Under the CAREC Transport Strategy 2030 and UN Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 3.6, Mongolia is working toward the target of reducing road traffic fatalities and serious injuries by 50 percent by 2030. To achieve this objective, the following measures are being implemented:



Introducing the iRAP 3-Star Road Safety Standard



Installing an integrated monitoring system with surveillance cameras and Weigh-in-Motion (WIM)



Integrating road, rail, logistics centers, border crossings, and customs operations into a unified transport network to facilitate seamless cross-border freight movement



Upgrading corridor roads to international standards under the CAREC Transport Strategy 2030 to increase trade and transit traffic while reducing logistics costs



Strengthening road maintenance and asset management systems to improve road quality, load-bearing capacity, and service life



Incorporating climate-resilient road engineering solutions into planning, design, and construction, taking into account Mongolia's harsh climate conditions and permafrost environment
