



Korea's AEO-MRA Status

Mutual Recognition Arrangement(MRA) is an arrangement between nations, which recognizes partner country's AEOs as same as those of their own based on a principle of reciprocity.

The KCS signed MRA with 23 countries.

- Full implementation : 19 countries
- Preparing for full implementation: 4 countries (Kazakhstan, Mongolia).

Introduction

UNI-PASS IS brand name of e-clearance system of KCS. It consists of 7 main module: Import Clearance, Duties Collections, Import Cargo Management, Export Cargo Management, Diuty Drawback, Single Window and modules.

KCS exported UNI-PASS to 15 countries \$321.67m since 2008




