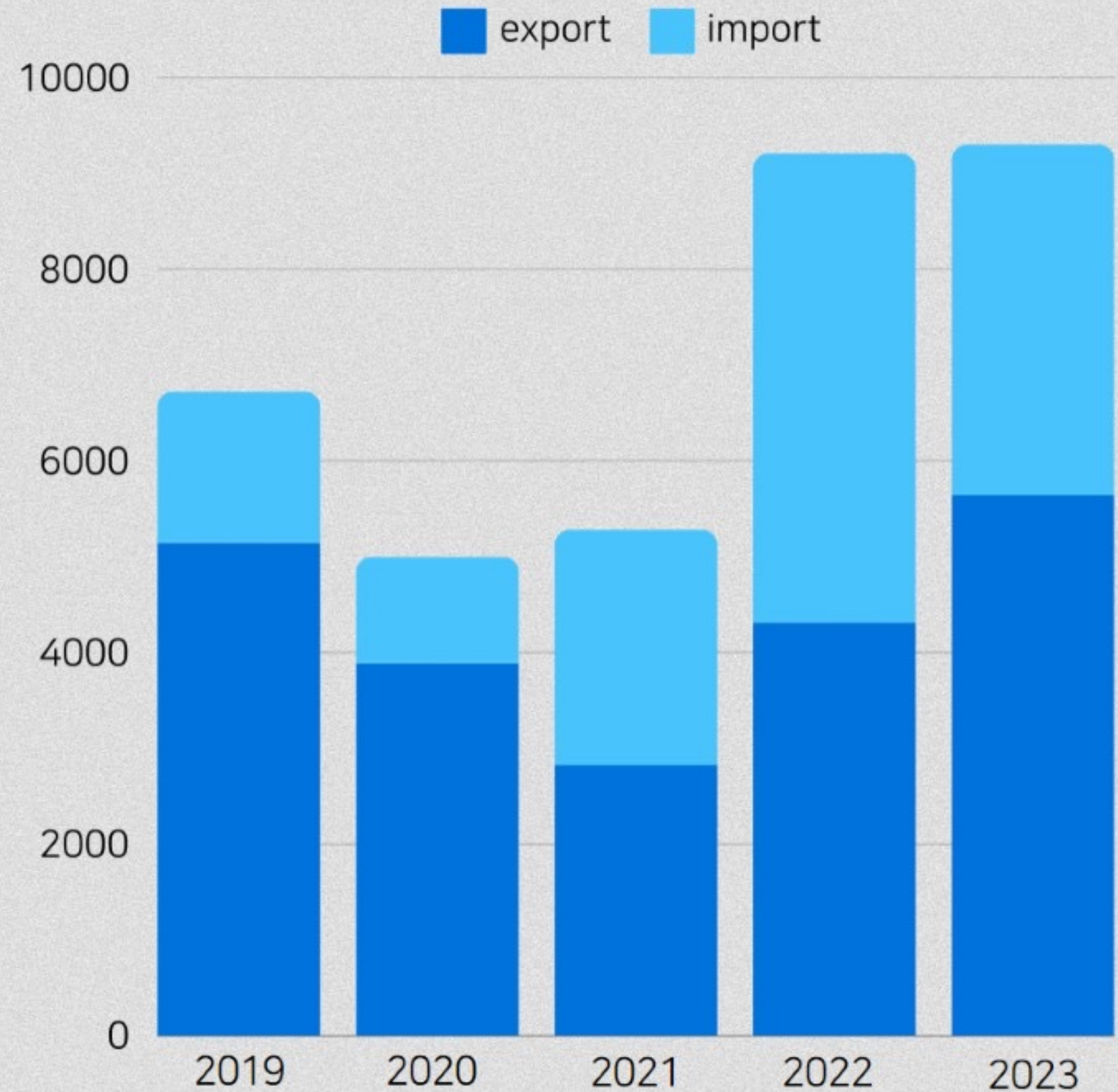


# 01

## Trade between Korea and Central Asia

In 2023, Korea's exports to Central Asia reached a record high of \$5.64 billion

(Export) automobiles and automobile parts, machinery and electronics, chemical products  
(Import) crude oil, natural gas and minerals

# 03 KCS's International Cooperation

## Multilateral Customs Cooperation

### WCO

KCS was designated as one of the WCO Regional Training Center(Cheonan), Regional Dog Training Center(Incheon), Regional Customs Laboratory(Jinju)

### WTO

Since it joined the WCO in 1995, the KCS has participated in DDA talks and proposed Korea's Single Window to be reflected on DDA.

### APEC

Since it joined the APEC in 1989, the KCS has actively participated in discussions for trade safety and facilitation. In 2025, APEC Summit will be held in Korea.

### Agreement on Cooperation and Mutual Assistance in Customs Matters

### Capacity-building program for customs officials of developing countries

The KCS has shared its experience in advancing customs administration so as to assist developing nations for their socio-economic development, for example in nurturing talented workforce in the field of customs administration. Such sharing efforts also improve the image of Korea around the world

## Korea's FTA Status

In Effect : 59 countries, 21 agreements

Signed : 10 countries, 5 agreements

- Korea-Uzbekistan FTA





# 03 KCS's International Cooperation

## Korea's AEO-MRA Status

Mutual Recognition Arrangement(MRA) is an arrangement between nations, which recognizes partner country's AEOs as same as those of their own based on a principle of reciprocity.

The KCS signed MRA with 23 countries.

- Full implementation : 19 countries
- Preparing for full implementation: 4 countries ( Kazakhstan, Mongolia)





# 03 KCS's International Cooperation

## UNI-PASS in other countries



### Introduction

UNI-PASS IS brand name of e-clearance system of KCS. It consists of 7 main module: Import Clearance, Duties Collections, Import Cargo Management, Export Cargo Management, Diuty Drawback, Single Window and modules.

### KCS exported UNI-PASS to 15 countries \$321.67m since 2008

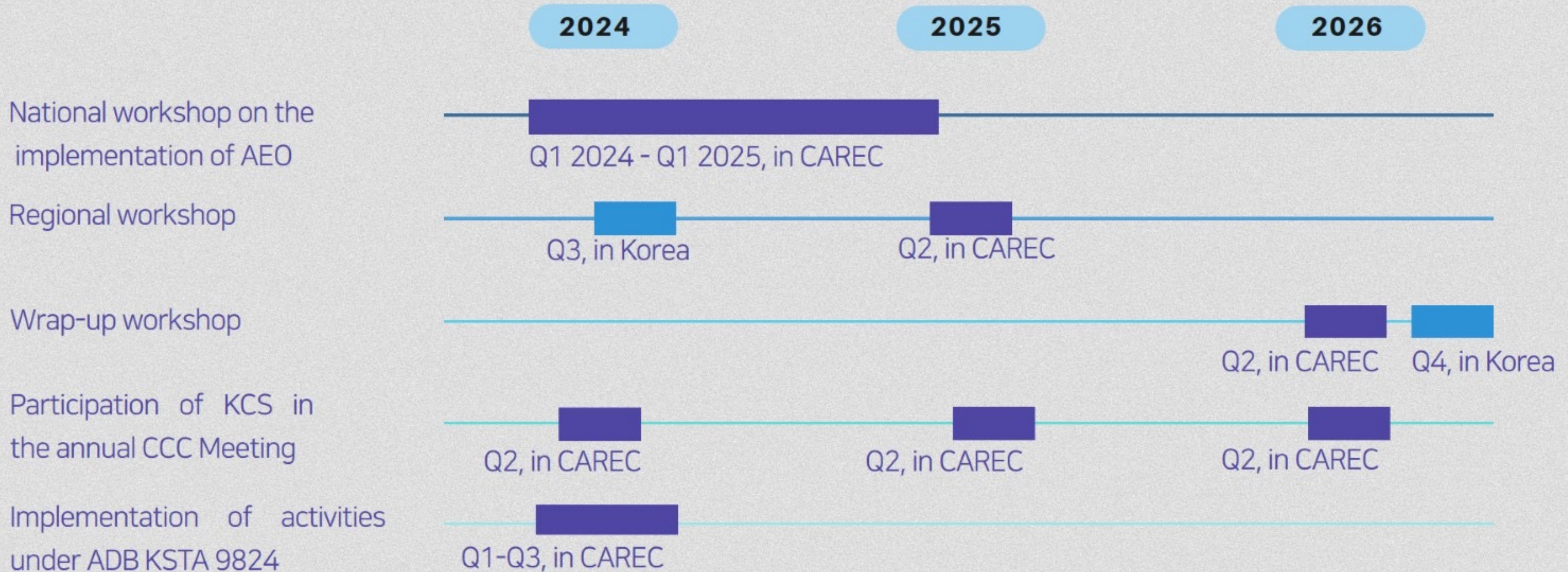
