CAREC Institute's trade related CB activities in 2015-2019

- **Focus**: providing knowledge services to the government officials in areas of border crossing services:
 - non-tariff barriers,
 - corridor performance measurement and monitoring instrument,
 - trade facilitation agreements,
 - ease of doing business, e-commerce, etc.

• Quantity Indicators:

- 21 out of 45 CB activities in 2015-2019 are related to trade, trade facilitation and economic corridors
- More than 500 government officials participated in CAREC Institute CB activities

• Quality indicators:

- Resource persons renowned international scholars and experts, authors of newly published books or had extensive experience in the CAREC region and program's thematic clusters from international development agencies, leading institutions

1	Workshop on Horticultural Value Chains	 high-end value addition to horticultural products which are eligible to be exported to high-end markets, including the European one, organization of the value chains, requisite standardization and certificates
2	Workshop on Ease of Doing Business	 CAREC member country domestic taxation structures, tax holidays for FDIs, details of taxation treaties to attract intra-regional FDI flows, elements of regional investment climate to improve ease of doing business
3	Workshop on CAREC Corridor Performance Measurement and Monitoring	 CPMM and TRS (Time Release Study by WCO), Constraints and bottlenecks hindering the flow of goods, Critical inputs in formulating viable solutions for improved CPMM
4	Workshop on WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement Implementation	 develop country roadmaps to review the status of implementation of WTO TFA among CAREC countries identify challenges and bottlenecks towards their full compliance with TFA commitments
5	Workshop on Special Economic Zones	 deepened the understanding of SEZs, formulating and implementing current development strategies for SEZs as regional connectivity hubs to promote both trade and diversification.
6	Workshop on Small and Medium Enterprise Trade Finance	 promote SME trade finance, enhance capacity of CAREC countries to provide enabling environment for SME trade finance through analyzing supply and demand challenges for SME
7	Workshop on E-commerce	 Enhancing of understanding of the economic, regulatory, and institutional environment of e-commerce and its links with regional trade

CAREC Institute's trade related CB and Research activities in 2020-2021 (PLAN)

- Capacity building, research and knowledge management efforts for 2020-2021 are prepared:
 - in **consultations** with the CAREC-2030 strategy, CAREC Institute- 2022, ADB sector committees, CAREC countries, partners, regional think tanks, and academia
- CAREC Institute will develop:
 - 4-day, **standardized workshops** in CAREC Program's priority clusters
 - **blended or hybrid learning prog**rams to utilize modern tools of knowledge sharing (face-to-face and virtual).
- During 2020-2021 CAREC Institute plans to deliver:
 - 3 trade related **workshops**: (i) CAREC corridor performance measurement and monitoring (CPMM), (ii) WTO TFA implementation; (iii) Operationalizing CAREC regional integration index (CRII)

CAREC Institute's trade related CB and Research activities in 2020-2021 (PLAN)

- During 2020-2021 CAREC Institute plans to deliver 2 research on:
 - Regulatory Framework for E-commerce development in the CAREC:
 - Analysis of e-commerce regulatory framework (economic, legal, and institutional) and provide an overview of e-commerce infrastructure, interoperability among various payment solutions, e-payment for cross-border e-commerce transactions and country's readiness to implement cross-border e-commerce and its potential contribution to trade in the CAREC region.
 - Regional Sanitary and Phytosanitary Regulatory Regime: Framework for Mutual Recognition and paperless certification exchange mechanism:
 - identify the CAREC Common Agenda for Modernization of SPS measures for trade by enabling paperless exchange of the SPS certification mechanisms.

CAREC Region: measuring Integration


- Mapping Policy Objectives with Integration Index
- Ease of **doing trade**: behind the border, at the border and beyond the border trading costs
- Theoretical framework- measurement, index construction, parameter selection, contextual framing, methodology and analytical framework
- Benchmarking measuring against stated policy objectives
- Open platform no formal agreements on Trade, Investment and Infrastructure and Trade Facilitation

CAREC INSTITUTE'S TRADE RELATED FLAGSHIP ACTIVITIES

CAREC Regional Integration Index (CRII)

- Integration is a dynamic and consensus-oriented process
- Measurement may be **complex and cumbersome** process
- CRII aims to measure the **depth and breadth of regional cooperation** on six socioeconomic dimensions
- Scale of 0 (low) to 1 (Full) Economic Cooperation
- provides **policy coordination and harmonization** for a targeted strategy and action plan to boast the regional cooperation and economic integration process

SIX PARAMETERS TO MEASURE CRII



CAREC REGION: FACTORS AFFECTING INTEGRATION (CRII RESULTS)

- Asymmetrical Market and Institutional (under) Development Constraints
- Market Access restrictions (trade in goods & services)
- Inconsistent and restrictive foreign direct investment (FDI) policies
- High trade **costs**
- Trade Facilitation and Economic connectivity
- Fragmentated Regionalism: Each member of CAREC is already party to at least one RTA and but no economic integration regionally

CAREC REGIONAL MARKET POTENTIAL

- Energy Market both traditional fossil fuels and Renewables
- Regional **Agriculture Market** potential (more than US\$ 200bn)
- Cross-border Free Zones and regional value chains
- Cross-border movement of goods, **services**, capital, and people
- **High-tech industrial** manufacturing and services sector
- Infrastructure and economic connectivity- High speed train and transportation
- Micro-trade, E-commerce and Eco-Tourism
- Transborder Governance of Regional Public Goods to mitigate the Climate Change impact (water, environment, etc.)
