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

Beside WTO-TFA measures additional efforts might be desirable.





(There was/is a substantial increase of the PRC's share.)





The revealed comparative advantages of intra-CAREC trade resemble the ones of overall CAREC trade.

Further reduced intra-CAREC trade barriers and better regional coordination could contribute to increased economies of scale and competitiveness of CAREC products.

Challenges...

The rather general conclusion:

Turbulent times ahead, a lot of work and coordination will be needed!!

- New industrial policies and geoeconomic fragmentation cause the reformulation of global trade (facilitation) policies and require the CAREC countries to reformulate also their own.





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
