- 2-day workshop: PPP projects simulation game, with hands-on task solving and decision making on project appraisal, structuring, procurement and negotiation

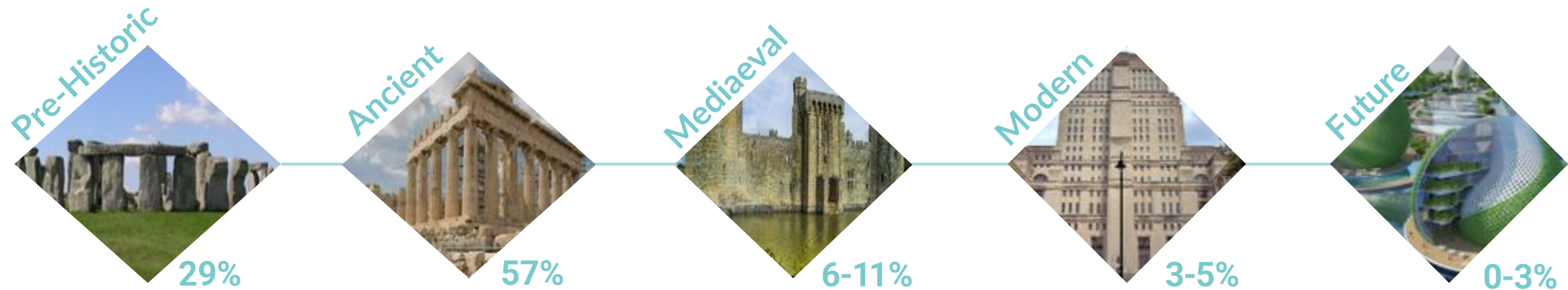
◆ PPP Course for a University Degree

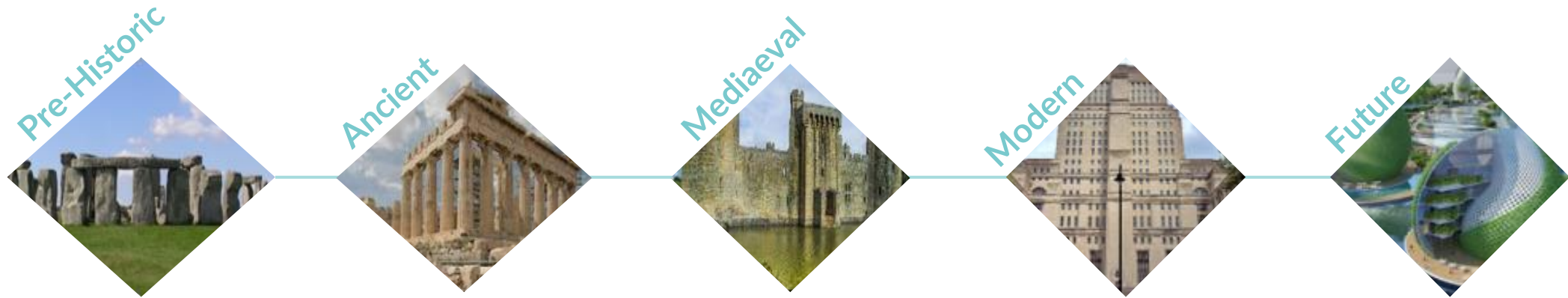
