

The three pillars of the ePhyto solution



Central server

A central server (the ePhyto Hub) located at the FAO premises that allows the exchange of ePhyto between National Plant Protection Authorities


Web-based generic system

A web-based generic system (the GeNS) that can produce and receive ePhytos, to allow countries that do not have a national electronic system to produce, send and receive ePhyto

Standard

A standard (the ISPM 12) for the structure and transmission of ePhyto with a harmonized format for mapping, codes and lists

Development with UNICC of an eBilling system that allows the electronic payment of fees associated with the ePhyto (both for single and multiple invoices) (pilot ongoing in Senegal)






89 countries successfully exchanging ePhytos (July 2024)
